DIRECTORS UPDATE

As you all know, we had major water clarity issues near the end of the season last year that caused our pool to be closed for several days. In order to address these issues, the pool committee is putting into place a two part plan.

Since clarity problems come from the buildup of minerals, part one of this plan is to change the water in the pool midseason. To do this, the facility will close on Tuesday, July 23rd and Wednesday, July 24th.

The second part of this plan is to make changes to our treatment facilities before the 2025 pool season.

With this approach, we hope to reduce the likelihood of a repeat of last year.
